

Case Study: Totara Parklands Development Region: Whangarei Client/Contractor: Broadspectrum

Outline:

- Stage 3 of the Totara Parklands development required installation of 12 manhole chambers on DN150 and DN225 lines.
- Stage 3 was a continuation of Broadspectrum's use of ROMOLD chambers after the completion of stage 5A.

Outcome:

- With experience gained from the previous stage the installation for Stage 3 was completed with a minimum of fuss.
- The speed of install was able to be exploited, leading to a much more efficient process.
- Feedback from the drainlayers was that this has now firmly become their preferred material for manhole chambers.
- Communication between the surveyor/designer and AML allowed for the chambers to be laid out according to their design constraints, resulting in a smooth installation process on site.
